Gen 1 & Gen 2 E-Foot Gear can be purchased at www.daedosouth.com. Gen 1- \$65 w/free shipping or on site for \$75. Gen2- \$85 w/free shipping or on site for \$90 (cash, Visa, MC, Discover).

Rules of Competition

Poomsae competition will be open to any traditional open hand forms. The competition will be bracketed, double elimination. Forms will be judged on correct and accurate movements, as well as balance, speed, power and fluidity or technique.

Board breaking will be judged according to USA Taekwondo rules. A complete list of these rules may be downloaded at http://www.teamusa.org/USA-Taekwondo.

Sparring rules will be modified USAT/WTF rules. There will be head contact for ALL age divisions. All colored belts under 18 will follow Junior Safety Rules. Black Belts 12 and under will follow Junior Safety Rules. Junior (15-17) will follow WTF rules. Adults will follow WTF rules.

A full Taekwondo uniform (white is preferred) will be required. No t-shirts. For sparring all competitors must have shin and instep protectors, forearm protectors, chest protector (e-hogu will be provided for red and black belts), head protector (white, red/blue), mouth guard, and groin cup for males. No glasses or sports goggles will be allowed.
